Certificate of Achievement

If you enjoy backpacking with your Irish Wolfhound, why not work towards a backpacking certificate of achievement for your IW? The starting level is called the Backpacking Companion Dog (BCD).

The BCD requires your IW to have backpacked a cumulative distance of 100 miles, including one backpacking trip of at least 30 miles.

NCIWC offers backpacking adventures that can fulfill the single trip millage requirement. Most novice/intermediate Irish Wolfhound backpackers can easily fulfill the BCD title requirements within two sea-

sons of backpacking.



Certificate of Achievement

For those backpackers and Irish Wolfhounds that backpack more than once a year, NCIWC rewards you with the Backpacking Trail Master certificate of achievement (BTM). The BTM requires your IW to have accumulated a total distance of 250 miles backpacking.



At this level of backpacking you can expect to hike an average of ten miles per day. The BTM can easily be achieved with three ten day trips at an intermediate level of backpacking abilities.





Globe Trekker

Certificate of Achievement

The Globe Trekker certificate of achievement (GT) is for the advanced backpacking Irish Wolfhound. The GT requires your IW to have accumulated a total distance of 500 miles backpacking.
