- 1) Take Exit 399B toward Munras Ave/ Monterey
- 2) In 0.4 Miles turn right onto Soledad Dr
- 3) Stay on Soledad Drive for app 0.2 miles, continuing under the highway underpass
- 4) Turn left onto Barnet Segal at the T-junction
- 5) Proceed on Barnet Segal for app. 0.5 miles
- 6) Bear right to remain on Barnet Segal near the directional sign for Westland House
- 7) Proceed a short distance on Barnet Segal and Look for the IW Signs at the Red and Iron Gate.
- 8) Proceed through the gates and continue straight up the gravel and dirt driveway for a couple hundred meters toward the old house to park.
