Regular Classes (\$15 per entry)

Puppy Regular Classes: 4 mos.- under 6 mos.; 6 mos. – under 9 mos.; 9 mos. – under 12 mos.

Adult Regular Classes: 12 mos. – 18 mos; Bred-by-Exhibitor; American Bred; Open

Junior Handling: FREE and no experience necessary. List Junior's name on official AKC entry form.

Non-Regular Classes (\$7 per entry)

Veteran (divided by sex; 6yrs and older); *Adult Brace; *Puppy Brace; Best Head; Best Movement; Best Type;

Pee Wee Class FREE

Regular classes will be divided by sex. Puppies will not compete against adults.

Irish Wolfhounds with points are welcomed and encouraged to compete. Champions of record are not allowed to enter. *Dogs entered in Brace must have one owner in common.

Pre-Entry: \$15; second entry of same dog \$7; Day of Match entries: \$20, second entry of same dog Day of Match \$10.

Junior Handling: FREE and no experience necessary (List Junior's name on official AKC form)

Activities

<u>Handling Class</u>: Learn how to present your hound in the show ring and practice some of the finer points of handling. This class is for everyone, whether you are a junior, novice or an experienced handler.

Canine Good Citizen & CGC Advanced testing – Limited Entries-MUST PRE-ENTER/No Same Day Entries. Cindy Steele will conduct the 10-step test, and your dog can earn his/her Official AKC CGC or CGCA title. Must have CGC to test for CGCA. Cindy will bring the paperwork. Bring a brush. For information, refer to the AKC - CGC Website. \$15 per test

<u>Junior Handling:</u> Open to any handlers under 18 years of age, handling any dog entered in the Match. Great opportunity to support the next generation! FREE

Pee Wee: This class is geared toward children 5–9 years of age. FREE

<u>Keeper of the Couch:</u> This class is open to all dogs in attendance, including sterilized hounds, veterans, titleholders, and all other beloved companions. Owners are requested to submit a short paragraph describing their special "Pride and Joy". This will be read while your hound is being presented in the ring. Please TYPE or WRITE CLEARLY on the form provided in this Premium List. Please share with us, so we can celebrate with you. \$5 dog.

Lunch: Pot Luck! Please bring something to share. Plates, utensils, cups provided.

Lure Fun Run: A short fun run for any age dog. \$5 per dog—as many runs as you wish or time allows.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particularvariety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Championsof Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog isdivided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If aregistered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
