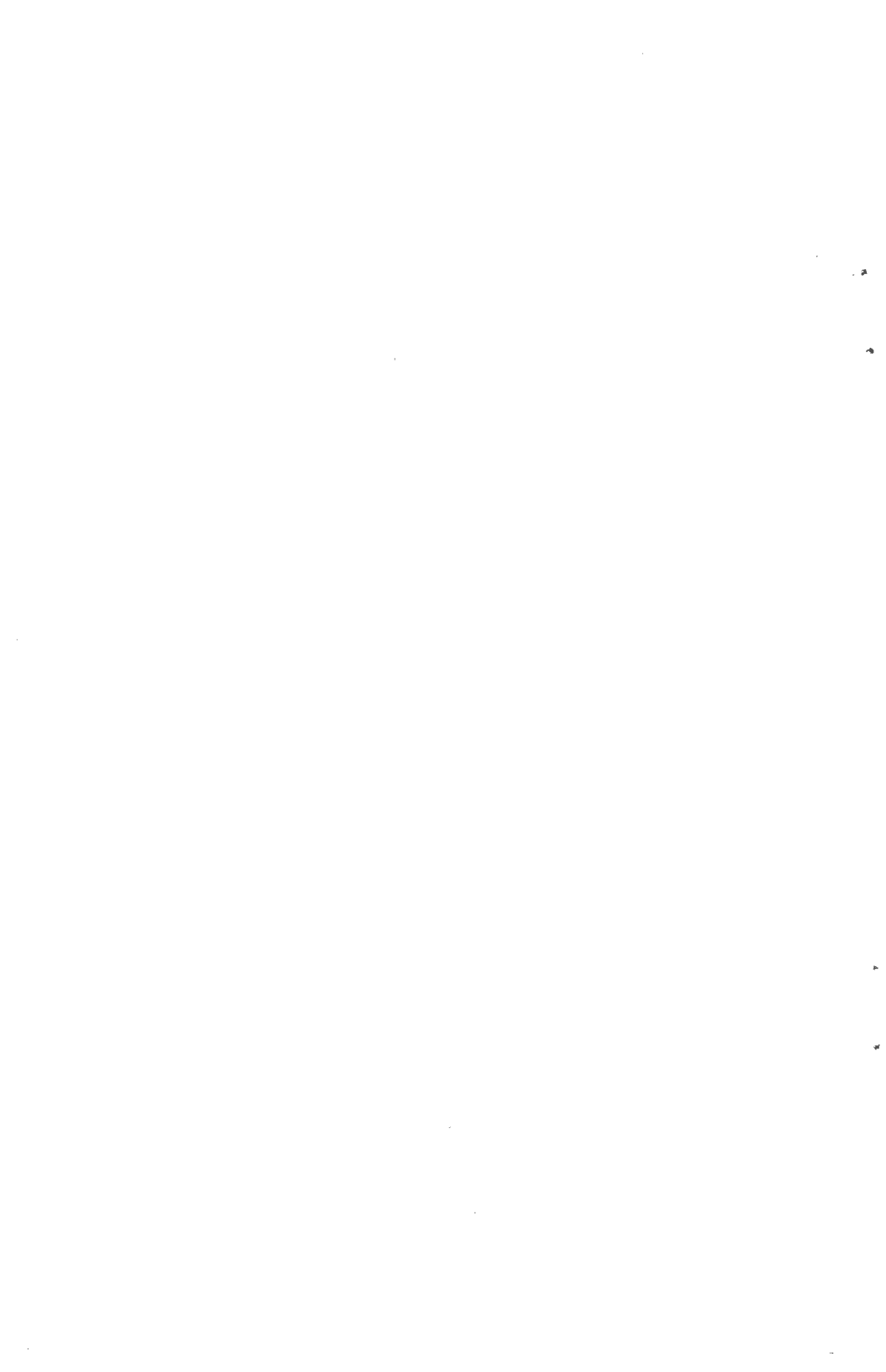

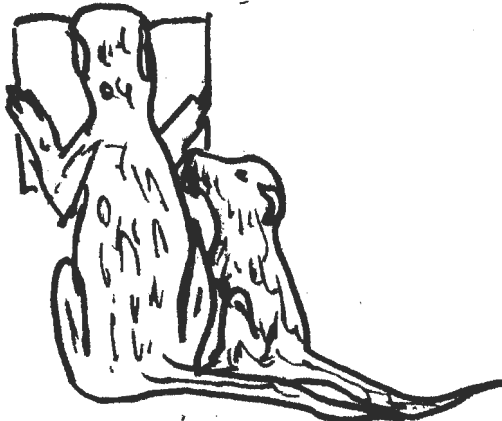



HEARTWORM DISEASE:

A spreading menace

Dogs can contract many forms of heart disease. One that pet owners should be aware of is heartworm disease.

This is a condition in dogs caused by a nematode (worm) called "Dirofilaria immitis" which lives as an adult in the right side of the heart. The male worms may be six inches long, while the females may be as much as 12 inches long.

Although it used to be a disease thought to be confined to other parts of the country, it has been identified in nearby areas of California. Now the disease knows no boundaries and is found in many parts of the country.

Heartworm disease is not a known threat to humans. It is transmitted from dog to dog by mosquitos. The present rise in heartworm disease cases may be attributed to 1) increased numbers of animals, 2) lack of mosquito abatement, and 3) more standing water as a result of people saving water in rain barrels and garbage cans during the present drought.

As the disease worsens in the dog, the infection will lead to tiring, labored breathing, coughing, and serious damage to the lungs. Without treatment, the dog will die of circulation failure.

Visible symptoms often do not occur until the worms have already caused their damage. However, a veterinarian can often diagnose the presence of heartworm disease before damage occurs. A cardiologist may wish to do a complete physical with X-rays, and blood studies.

Once established, heartworm disease is difficult to control, since there is no immunization vaccine available, and mosquitos will never be completely eliminated. The best prevention is to keep heartworms from

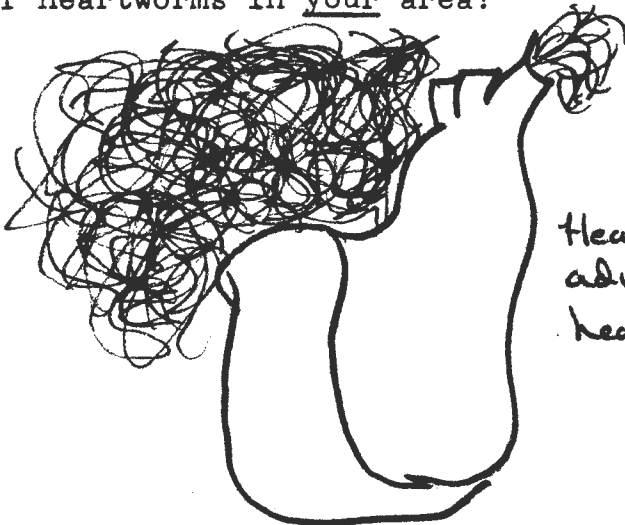
reaching the damaging adult stage in your dog.

It is advisable to have your dog brought in to a veterinarian periodically for a check-up for heartworm disease. The disease can be controlled when diagnosed early enough.

**Heartworms are a serious threat to our Wolfies, not always having the strongest hearts to begin with! In our county alone, they are diagnosing over 90 cases of heartworm per month. Overlooking the expense of the treatment (\$100+ for an IW), what you actually must do is poison your dog with arsenic. The dog must be kept perfectly still during the duration of the treatment. Needless to say, not all dogs survive. On the other hand, if your dog tests clear (a blood test, costing about \$6), you can prevent the occurrence of heartworms entirely by administration of a pill(s) every day. Why not check with your own vet (or with several local vets) on the occurrence rate of heartworms in your area?

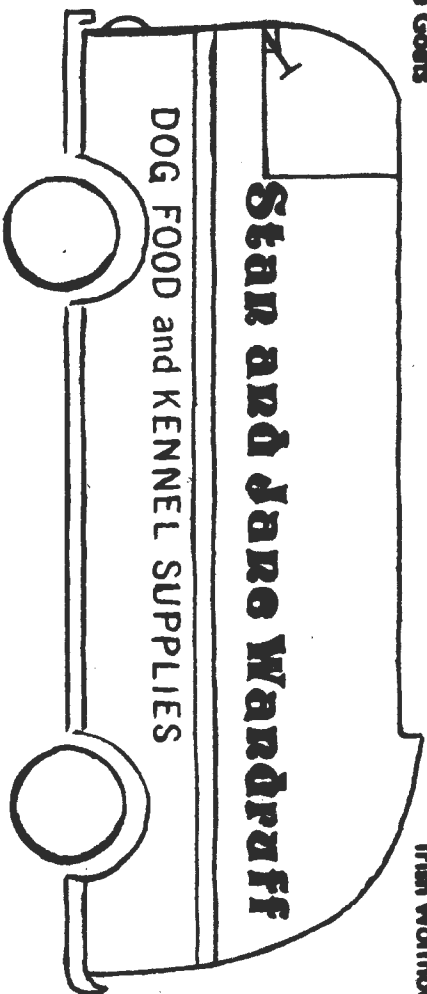
