BOARD MEETING
August 8, 1980

The meeting was called to order at 8:10 p.m. at the Marin County Humane Society by President Richard Heskett. Officers and members present were Mary & Harold Major, Greg Shaw, Marty Mulac, Yvonne & Richard Heskett, Ken & Carol Gabriel, John & Belle Hays, Ken Taylor, Russ Greene, John Fitzpatrick and Paula Silverman.

The secretary's minutes were read and approved as corrected. The treasurer reported \$651.35 in the treasury as of 8/8 with all bills paid to date. The insurance for Golden Gate Park will cost \$114 for property damage and \$67 for personal injury to give us the \$1 million coverage required by the park. We will manipulate dates on the policy so that we will have this rider in effect for one year. There are 34 members still unpaid out of a total of 75. John will send a reminder note to those delinquent. The Bugle editor was authorized to charge for any ads submitted for publication. John suggested that we cut the size of the Bugle to reduce expenses, but this suggestion was overruled with other suggestions being offered instead. These included a Stud page, Brag page, more ads, a Dr.'s column.

Movies- John took a roll of film at Contra Costa and would like to pass the job along for the next shows. Russ Greene and John decided to be in charge of Santa Cruz/Salinas.

Old Business-

Lure Coursing- Ken got three pulleys from Gordon Turnage. That gives us a total of 5, we are still short 2. Our lure machine does work now. The next course will be mid-October or early November. November 15 is the preferred date, with locations suggested: Golden Gate polo field, J.F. Kennedy School in Daly City. It will be an all-breed course.

Match- 142 premium lists were sent out (\$34 printing, \$21.30 stamps), \$15 fee sent to AKC. The vet will be either John Fitzpatrick or someone John will arrange for.

New Business-

Our next meeting will be at Coyote Point Humane Society on October 17th. Sharon Yas-kulski will make the arrangements, Mary Major will be in charge of a program. We have a new membership form designed by Ken and Carol Gabriel.

The meeting was adjourned at 9 p.m.

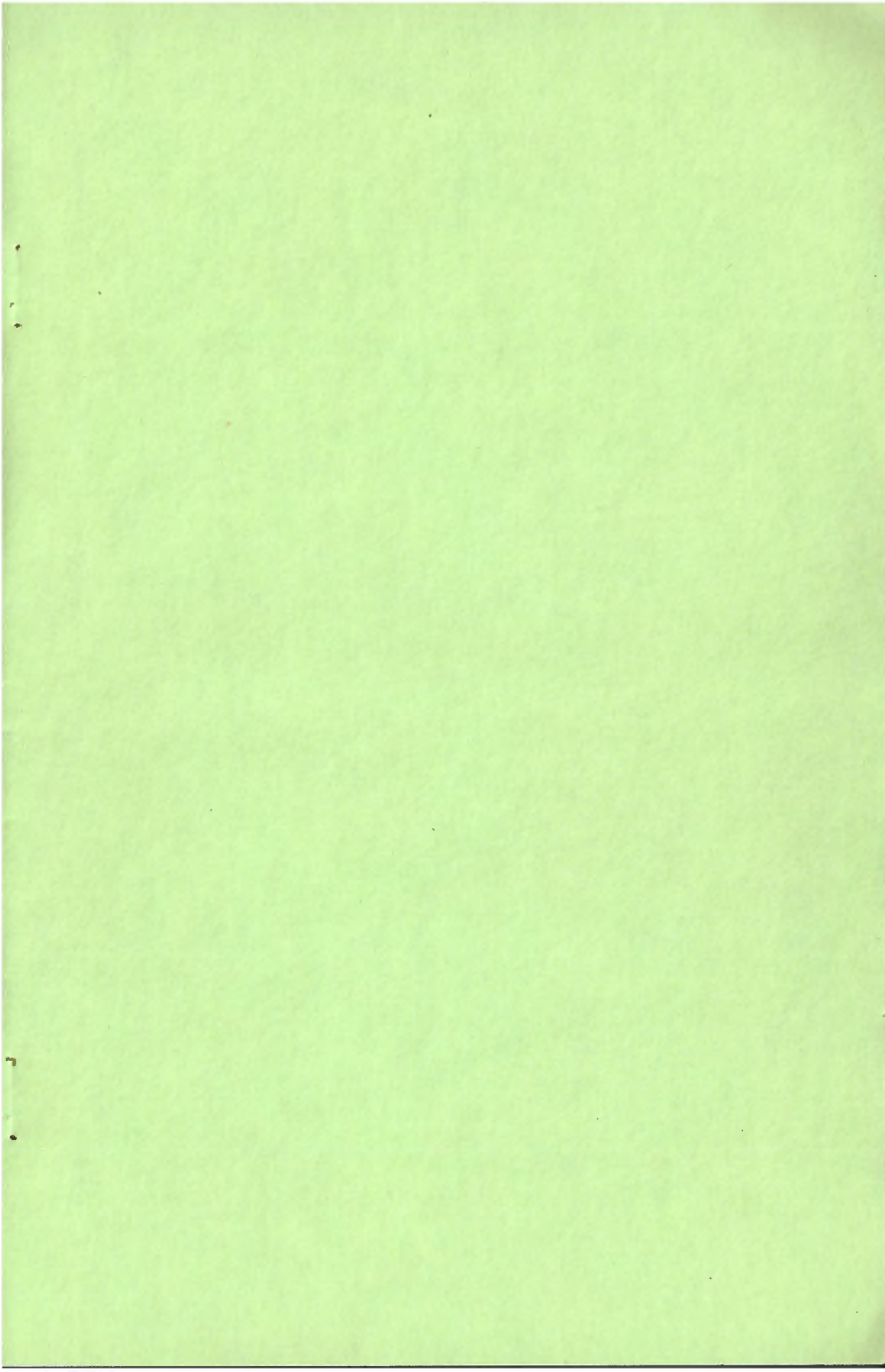
