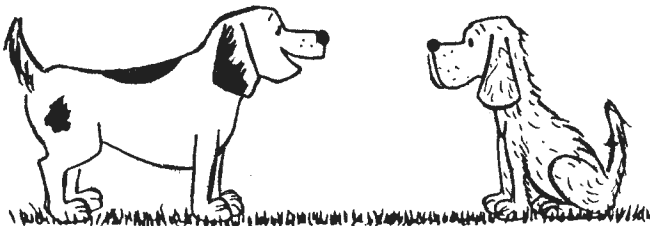

Getting back to our Specialty Show, it was decided that we offer Puppy Sweepstakes but not extra classes i.e. gait, head, type, etc.

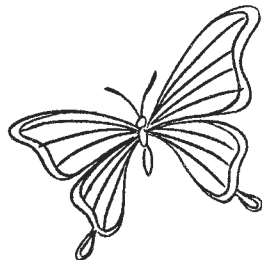
Greg said that challenge trophies should cover different classes so that we do not have more than one trophy for a class and none for another.

BRAG TIME: We had many, many brags and raised \$60.00 for the Club's treasury!!!!

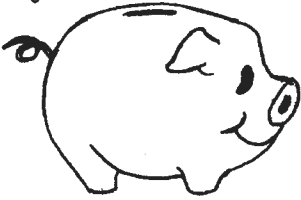
There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

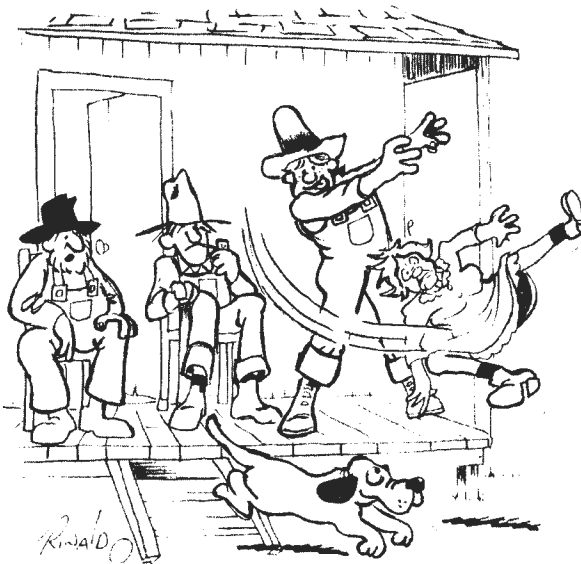

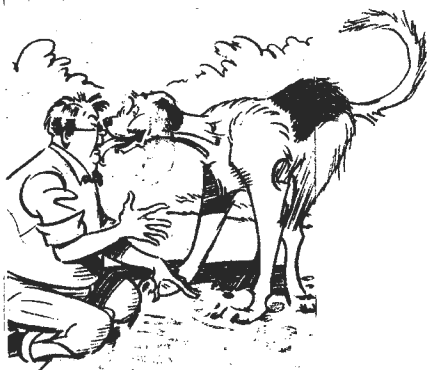
## WOLF-LAND

Ancient records indicate that from the earliest times, Ireland had a very large population of wolves running wild, and one particular book, The Travels of Cosmos (1669), says the country was known far and wide as 'Wolf-Land.' For this reason, the people reared a special breed of dog, a tall, rough greyhound of exceptional size and power, the Wolfhound, to hunt and kill the fierce packs. It is perhaps not surprising, therefore, that werewolves, men with the ability to change into animals, are recorded from antiquity down through the years of the country's history. The metamorphosis of man into wolf, known as Lycanthropy, was supposed to take place at night when the moon was full, and in Ireland it was believed that it ran in families.

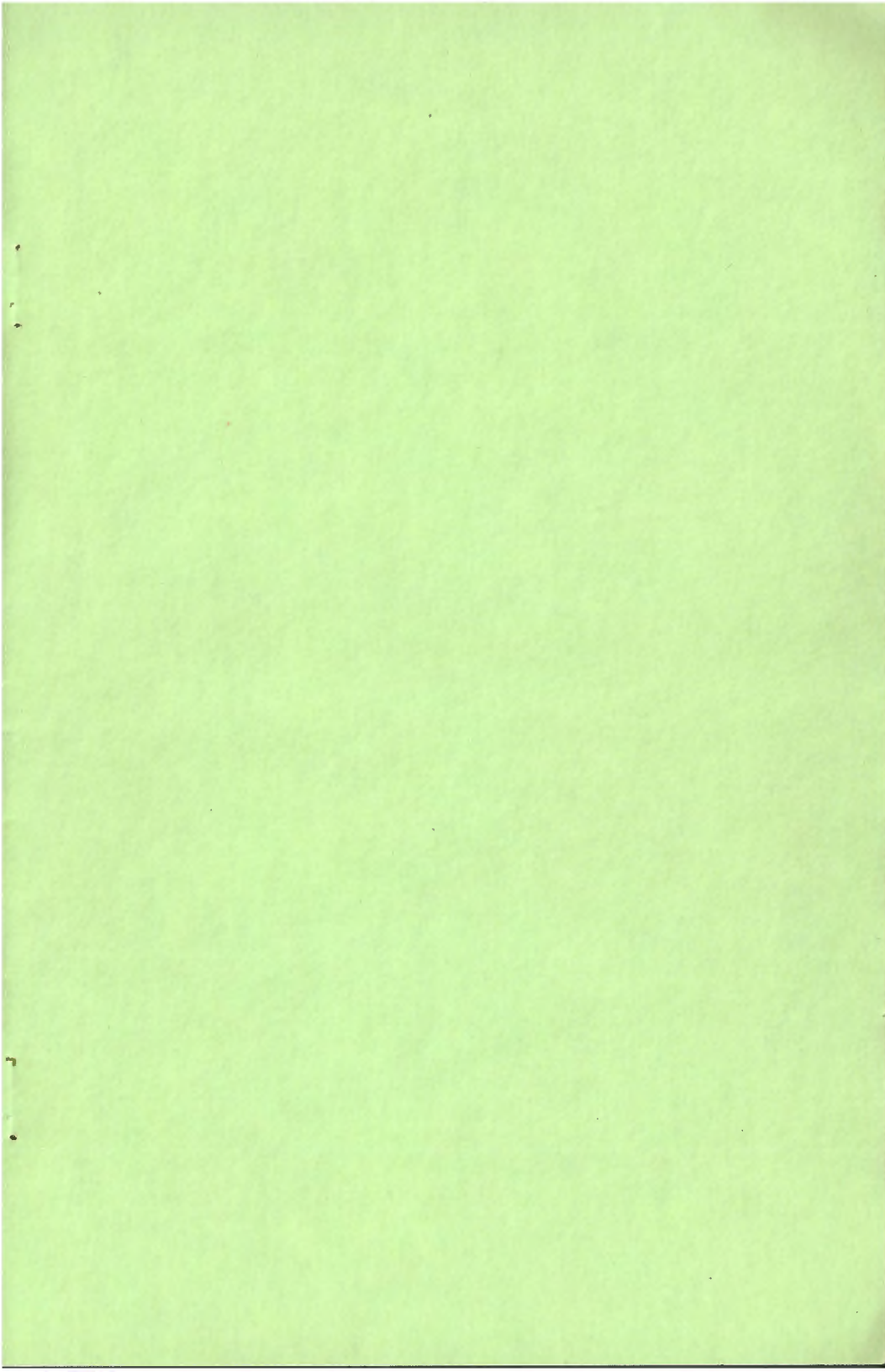
