ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY--Only purebred Irish Wolfhounds, that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) may be entered.

TESTS OFFERED:

JUNIOR COURSER, QUALIFIED COURSER TEST Any eligible sighthound.

The course is a minimum of 600 yards with a minimum of four (4) turns.

JUNIOR COURSER (JC): A hound running alone shall receive one qualification from a judge, and a second qualification from a different judge at a separate event, stating that the hound completed the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

QUALIFIED COURSER (QC): A hound (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. **The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course.**

STAKES OFFERED:

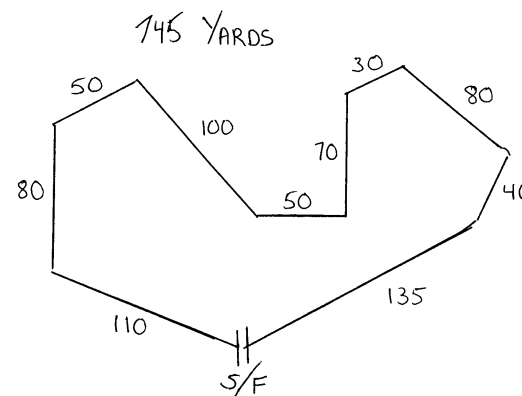
OPEN: Open to Irish Wolfhounds of an eligible breed that have obtained at least one of the following: AKC Qualified Courser Title, ASFA or CKC Field Champion Title (must show copy of championship certificate). Hounds that are disqualified from AKC may not be entered.

SPECIAL: Open to Irish Wolfhounds that are eligible to enter the Open Stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship Title. No championship points are awarded from this stake.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to Irish Wolfhounds who must be at least 5 years of age. . Championship points will be awarded.

All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Entry fees for hounds excused during inspection for bitches in season, lameness, or disqualifications will be refunded. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The members of the Northern California Irish Wolfhound Club reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test/trial. **A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in Bathroom will be available.** NCIWC assumes no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after these Tests/Trials.
