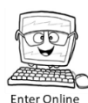

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee less \$10.00 cancellation fee provided that a veterinarian's certificate and written notification is given to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the first class of the day of the first trial entered.

PARADE OF VETERANS CLASS (Saturday) - This is a noncompetitive class for dogs or bitches that are six (6) years of age or older. Each entrant will receive a club-decorated rosette. Full particulars must be given for each dog on the Official AKC entry form if the Parade is the only entry for the dog. Participants may submit a brief (e.g., 100 words max) narrative to be read over the public address system during the Parade. A neutered male may enter the Veteran Dog Class & a spayed bitch may enter the Veteran Bitch Class. Winners are eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT

The Club offers an Award of Merit to deserving Irish Wolfhounds for recognition of their quality. It is entirely at the judge's discretion whether to give all or none of the available Awards. Awards of Merit are selected from the Irish Wolfhounds in the Best of Breed Competition, other than Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Select Dog and Select Bitch. **AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGE UP TO 3 AWARDS OF MERIT MAY BE AWARDED.**

BEST PUPPY, BEST VETERAN DOG, BEST VETERAN BITCH

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, none of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed two get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. **All get must be entered in a regular class** in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Brace Class: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. *Dogs must be entered in a regular or non-regular class, or Best of Breed competition at this show.* Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

Team Class: Four Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in the team class must have at least one common owner. *Dogs must be entered in a regular or non-regular class, or Best of Breed competition at this show.* Dogs comprising a Team Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Team is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Team

Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Team must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Team Class."

Extended Generation Competition Entry Fee: \$20.00 for the Unit. This extraordinary class entry is to be made up of a minimum of three generations, each descended from the one above. (i.e., Dogs A, B & C: A is sire or dam of B who is sire or dam of C.) Only one representative from each generation is allowed. *Dogs must be entered in a regular or non-regular class, or Best of Breed competition at this show.* Judge's decision is based on the consistency maintained through multiple generations in a breeding program. Dog A (the grandparent) is the dog entered. Entries must be made on the regular entry form as an Additional Class. The Winner is not eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. First Place only will be awarded in this class. Dogs do not need to be owned or bred by same person. Winner of class is Dog A. **Extended Generation Perpetual Trophy:** The Hounds of Carroy Trophy, "Hounds at Rest" sculpted by Sally Polk, on a wooden base, offered by Lynne & Dick Rosebrock.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

Eligibility: Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Wolfhounds who, on the date of the show, shall be at least 6 months and under 18 months of age. Sweepstakes Classes will be judged prior to the Regular Breed Classes. **All dogs entered must be entered in one of the regular classes** at the regular entry fee. Junior and Senior Sweepstakes will be judged separately and there will be no competition between the two divisions. Winners of the Junior classes will compete for Best Junior in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best Junior in Sweepstakes. Winners of Senior Classes will compete for Best Senior in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best Senior in Sweepstakes. Please indicate your Sweepstakes class with the appropriate age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes."

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION

Eligibility: Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Wolfhounds who, on the date of the show, shall be 6 years of age and over. Veteran Sweepstakes Classes will be judged prior to Puppy Sweepstakes. **Dogs entered need not be entered in one of the regular classes.** Dog and Bitch Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged separately. Winners of the Veterans classes will compete for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best Veteran in Sweepstakes. Trophies will not be awarded for the Veteran Sweepstakes classes. Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Irish Wolfhounds that, on the date of the show, qualify to be judged within their age groups. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" with appropriate age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes."

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:

- **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
- **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

Northern California Irish Wolfhound Club All-Star Hound Award

The Irish Wolfhound is a very versatile breed. The NCIWC endorses and encourages members to participate in different dog sports that both the owners and their dogs enjoy. The NCIWC would like to recognize those owners and hounds who have displayed outstanding teamwork. Teams who have participated in multiple activities, including conformation, obedience, rally, trick dog, scent work, agility, lure coursing, racing, open field coursing are urged to enter.

Rules

1. To enter the hound must have points in a minimum of 3 groups *and* be entered in the NCIWC Specialty
2. Points are awarded for titles in different sports (groups). The more difficult/highest title in each category is the number of points counted. For example, a dog with Junior and Senior Courser would get 2 points (for Senior Courser), not 1+2=3points, (for Junior +Senior Courser)
3. In the event of a tie for first place, the dog with points in the most groups would win.
4. Titles can be accumulated over multiple years.
5. Photocopies of title certificates and awards to be submitted with entry.

Groups: Conformation (points with 1major or higher), Obedience, Rally, Trick Dog, Tracking, Scent Work, Agility, Lure Coursing, Racing (LGRA/NOTRA, Fast-Cat), Open Field Coursing, Temperament ((includes CGC and higher, Farm Dog, Therapy Dog, Temperament Tested)

Award - Each entry in the All-Star Hound Competition will receive a certificate and NCIWC Medallion. The winner will receive a Rosette and their name added to the NCIWC All-Star Perpetual Trophy.

No award will be mailed. If a trophy listed is unavailable, a Trophy of equal or greater value will be awarded.

1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, DogZibit, P. O. Box 2044, Woodinville, WA 98072-2044 by the closing date & time specified in the Premium List. After which time no entries can be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations. Fees must accompany entries; DogZibit assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
2. No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, FAX email, phone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
