Activities

Grooming and Education Station: Something new: Bring your dog over to the "grooming station" where club members will be available to answer your questions and help you with grooming. Lynne Rosebrock will go over the IWCA illustrated standard posters for your educational enjoyment. \$5

Handling Class: Learn how to present your hound in the show ring and practice some of the finer points of handling. This class is for everyone, whether you are a junior, novice or an experienced handler. A great way for you and your dog to get some practice prior to the Match judging. Games – Cindy Steele will set up an Easter Egg hunt for dogs and their owners. \$5 per entry. Bring a basket for your eggs. Find the special eggs for special prizes.

Canine Good Citizen & CGC Advanced testing – Lynne Rosebrock will conduct the 10-step Test and your dog can earn his/her Official AKC CGC or CGCA title. She will bring the paperwork. Bring a brush. *For information, refer to the AKC - CGC Website.* \$10 per test (only held if a minimum of 2 dogs in each class are entered)

Keeper of the Couch: This class is open to all dogs in attendance, including spayed and neutered hounds, veterans, titleholders, and all other beloved companions. Owners are requested to submit a short paragraph describing their special "Pride and Joy". This will be read while your hound is being presented in the ring. Please TYPE or WRITE CLEARLY on the form provided below. Please share with us, so we can celebrate with you. \$5 per entry.

Lunch: Lunch will be "potluck" and will follow the completion of the Keeper of the Couch presentations. Please bring a dish to share and your own drink. Paper plates, napkins and utensils will be provided by the club.

Lure Practice: NCIWC will provide a fun run for any age dog. Donation at the time of the lure course to help maintain equipment.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
