**TESTS OFFERED:**

**JUNIOR COURSER, QUALIFIED COURSER TEST** Any eligible sighthound over 1 year old. The course is a minimum of 600 yards with a minimum of four (4) turns.

**JUNIOR COURSER (JC):** A hound running alone shall receive one qualification from a judge, and a second qualification from a different judge at a separate event, stating that the hound completed the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

**QUALIFIED COURSER (QC):** A hound (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. **The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course.**

**STAKES OFFERED:**

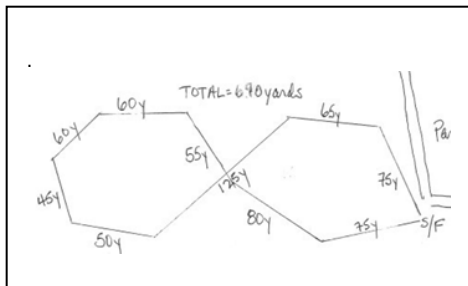
**OPEN:** Open to Irish Wolfhounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate or an ASFA Certification Course certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title of record are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

**SPECIAL:** Open to Irish Wolfhounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles.

**OPEN VETERAN:** Open to Irish Wolfhounds 5 years or older which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes.

**SINGLE STAKE:** Open to Irish Wolfhounds 1 year of age or older, QC not necessary, title points not awarded from this stake. Not eligible for Best of Breed, Hound runs alone twice.

All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Entry fees for hounds excused during inspection for bitches in season, lameness, or disqualifications will be refunded. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Battery powered continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The members of the Northern California Irish Wolfhound Club reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test/trial. A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hound. Bathrooms will be available. NCIWC assumes no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after these Tests/Trials.
